statement as on 1.1.1979.

Ref:- 1) G.O.No.ED 141 UPC 77, dt: 6.10.1977 and 29.10.'77

2) Your letter No. RAse/USG/Salary/179.80 dt 24.7.79

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With reference to the subject and reference cited above, I am to enclose herein the statement showing the salary due to the employee of your institution from the month of January 1979 duly approved subject to authorised deductions as in the previous year. The salary now approved will be in force for the period from 1.1.1979 to 31.12.1979. The Principals are requested to check the total amounts once again before the salary is drawn...

The increment due on 1.1.1979 has been taken to account while fixing the pay on 1.1.1979. Wherever the increment falls due on a date other than the first, the increment may be drawn from the first of that month. In respect of the employees whose increment is due after 1.1.1979 but before 31.12.1979, the increment may be drawn at the prescribed rate only after obtaining the sanction of the Management under intimation to this Directorate.

As regards the Lecturers appointed against the vacancies of the teachers deputed under the University Grants Commission Scheme of Faculty Improvement Programme their salary, should not be authorised from the Joint Account under any circumstances as the same has to be got reimbursed from the University Grants

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Commission. The pay of the Demonstrators deputed for obtaining M.Sc degree should not also be drawn without specific sanction of the Director.

Before authorising the payment of salary to the teaching staff members the principals is requested to see that all the teaching staff members are having the required minimum qualification (Second Class Master Degree) and they are having the prescribed work-load. Where an employee does not have the prescribed work-load, he shall be engaged only as a part-time employee and paid accordingly as per clause I(i) of the agreement.

In respect of the teaching staff appointed through the Selection Committee who are included in the statement, their salary should be drawn only till 31.3.1979. They should be paid from 1.4.1979. (Vacation salary) as per Government Order No.ED 62 UGC 60 dated 11.1.1960 followed by leave without allowance for the rest of the vacation, after obtaining separate authorisation from the Directorate. They will be again on duty on re-opening of the College.

In respect of the employees whose superannuation falls due in the middle of the academic year but re-employed should not be drawn from the Joint Account; their salary may be got re-imbursed from this Directorate after their pension is fixed.

Attention is invited to the accompanying observation Memo. The Principals are requested to take necessary action in compliance with the observations made. It is observed that monthly returns regarding drawal of salary are not forwarded to this Directorate regularly as required in para 11 of the letter No.DCE.110.G/S.77, dated 7.1.1977. The Principals are requested to ensure that these are submitted regularly in future along with the pending statements. Any lapse in this regard will be seriously viewed in future.

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The Principals are required to furnish the following certificates in the monthly pay bill.

CERTIFIED THAT:

- 1) The employees on whose behalf salaries are drawn in this bill are approved by the Director in annual/supplementary statement.
- 2) The salaries and allowances drawn in this bill pertain to the periods during which the employees were on duty or sanctioned leave to which they were entitled. Leave accounts have been maintained in the Office and the Service Registers.
- 3) After submission of the salary grant bill during the previous month if there have been cases of leave absence etc., affecting pay, necessary adjustments have been made in the current month by short drawal.
- 4) Absentees statement is enclosed.
- 5) The amount claimed in this bill has not been claimed in any of the previous bills of this Office.
- 6) There are no overaged employees in this salary bill.
- 7) The members of the teaching staff had full work load as prescribed by the Department during this month. //

The expenditure on payment of salary to staff for January 1979 may be met out of the balance amount (two months salary and allowances) available in the Joint Account of the College without waiting for the receipt of the countersigned grant-in-aid bill from the Directorate.

The Principals should ensure that un-authorized with-drawals are not made from out of the Joint Account under any circumstances. (X)
